


Disease Prioritization

Rabies circle of neglect: Fuelled by poor laboratory diagnosis and surveillance





Disrupting the cycle

Good data vs Poor data

Good data	Poor data
✓ Accurate	X Partially complete
🗸 Timely	X Late
✓ Can be analysed further	X Irrelevant to specific aim
✓ Meaningful	X Never analysed/processed

Obtaining data... is not always easy!

- Determine the true burden of the disease
- Influence decisions to improve control efforts
- A platform for advocacy

 - Support
 - Recognition
- Evaluate progress towards elimination
