

WHAT TO DO... IF YOU GET BITTEN:

1. Wash the wound

with running clean water and mild soap for 10 minutes



2. Apply a disinfectant

Dry the wound and apply a disinfectant such as betadine



3. Quarantine the dog

to observe symptoms for 10 days



4. See a doctor

for treatment and vaccination plan



STOP RABIES WITH 5 DON'TS



1. DON'T TEASE
the animal



2. DON'T STEP
on the animal's tail, limbs
– don't startle the animal



3. DON'T SPLIT
dog fights with
bare hands



4. DON'T TAKE AWAY
dog's food or toy when in use



5. DON'T TOUCH
puppies who are with their mom

HOW TO... PREVENT RABIES

VACCINATION

Rabies is preventable with annual vaccination. Vaccinating at least 80% of the dog population against rabies protects the community against rabies. Vaccinate your dog or cat immediately after adoption, and then every year, to reduce the risk of infectious disease and prevent rabies.



STERILISATION

Sterilisation decreases fighting and roaming behaviours of dogs, helping reduce the spread of rabies.

your pets every year!"
